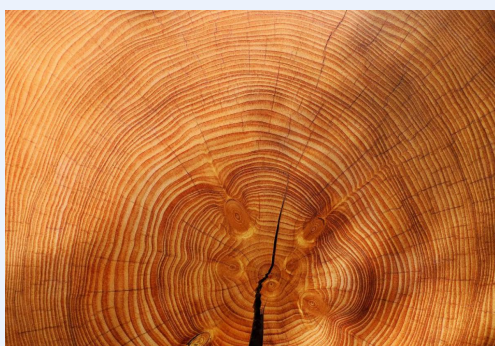

## Units in Forest Carbon Numbers: A Primer
