FOREST 2025, the 83rd session of the UNECE Committee on Forests and the Forest Industry (COFFI) is scheduled for November 4-6, 2025 in Geneva, Switzerland. This high-level gathering at the Palais des Nations will bring together forestry professionals, policymakers and industry stakeholders from across the region to advance dialogue on sustainable forest management and wood-product sectors. Sessions will cover topics from climate resilience to innovation in forest-based industries, alongside meetings of COFFI's specialist teams and thematic workshops.
